



## Memorandum of Understanding Between The Faculty of Dentistry, Prince of Songkla University and The Faculty of Dentistry, University of Hong Kong

- 1. The Faculty of Dentistry, Prince of Songkla University and the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Hong Kong, desiring to develop academic exchange and cooperation in teaching and research for the advancement and dissemination of learning, hereby agree to implement, within the framework of the regulations applying in each of the institutions and subject to the availability of resources, the following programmes and activities:
  - (a) Exchange of existing staff
  - (b) Joint research activities
  - (c) Participation in seminars and academic meetings
  - (d) Exchange of academic materials and other information
  - (e) Exchange of students
- 2. The terms of such mutual assistance and the necessary budget for each programme and activity implemented under the terms of this agreement will be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of the particular programme or activity.
- 3. The institutions acknowledge that all visits of staff and the admission of students will be subject to compliance with entry and visa regulations of Thailand and Hong Kong, and the institutions' requirements in respect of student admission and staff appointments.
- 4. The administration of this agreement shall be in the hands of the Office of International Relations at the Faculty of Dentistry, Prince of Songkla University of Thailand and the Registry of the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Hong Kong.
- 5. This agreement shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last signature, on the understanding that it may be automatically renewed for another term of five years upon each expiry. The agreement may also be terminated by either party giving six months prior notice to the other party in writing.
- 6. This agreement may be amended by the exchange of letters between the two institutions. Such amendments, once approved by both institutions, will become part of this Memorandum of Understanding.
