The Component of the Additional Thesis Format

1. Cover

- 1) **Size** A4
- 2) **Outer Cover** This page contains the thesis title, author's name, degree and field of study and the graduation year. The last line must state that the thesis is the copyright of Prince of Songkla University. The outer cover is made of hard paper covered with dark blue, rough side. It must be printed in both Thai and English with white letters.
- 3) **The spine** of the thesis contains details of the thesis title, author's name and graduation year in both Thai and English.
- 4) Back Cover

2. Blank Page

- **3. Title Page** This page has the same content as the Outer Cover.
- **4. Approval Page** This page contains the thesis title, author's name, Major Advisor, coadvisor(s), members of the Examining Committees and the Dean of the Graduate School.
- **5. Certification** The certified content signed by the author and advisor.
- **6. Abstract Page** This page contains the thesis title, author's name, major program, academic year. The abstract should include objectives, goals, scope of the research, research methodology and research findings. It must be accurate, complete, precise, concise and clear. It should only report significant findings and statistical data of the research. It must not exceed 1 page in Thai and 1 page in English.
- 7. Acknowledgement Page Acknowledgements are statements of gratitude to any individual, institution and/or agency that provided assistance or cooperation during the course of the work reported in the thesis. They should be extended to members of the Thesis Advisory Committee, Thesis Defense Committee, financial support or individual who provided suggestions and information as well as those who permitted the use of their writings and research equipment. Acknowledgements should be written in plain academic style and avoid using spoken and colloquial language. Individuals should be referred to by the first name-family name with titles, ranks of authority, titles conferred by priestly rank. It must not exceed 1 page.
- **8.** Contents This page outlines the main sections of the thesis in a proper order of page numbers.
- **9. List of Tables** (if any). This page lists the captions and page number of all the tables that appear in the thesis.
- **10. List of Figures/Illustrations** (if any). This page lists the page number of all figures (figures, maps, charts and graphs) in the thesis.

- **11. List of Abbreviations and Symbols** (if any). This page describes the symbols and abbreviation used in the thesis.
- 12. Lists of Papers and Proceedings should be printed on both sides of the paper.

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13. Summary of Contents

- 1) **Introduction** consists of background information for the thesis and significance of further research.
- 2) Objectives
- 3) **Result and Discussion** to describe and summarize through analysis and synthesis all important findings.
- 4) Concluding remarks This section summarizes the whole thesis while indicating any limitations of the research results and providing suggestions for further research and possible research benefits and applications.
- **14. Bibliography and References**. This section comprises of list of the references that details titles of books, publications, audiovisual materials etc.
- **15. Appendices** are supplementary texts that cannot be included in the text section but can enhance thesis comprehension and any relevant research data that were not directly cited in the thesis.

16. Vitae is the author's biography which appears on the last page. This page should include the following information of the author:

	List of publications and proceedings
