

**The announcement by the Faculty of Dentistry  
Prince of Songkla University, Thailand  
The 2023 PSU-Faculty of Dentistry International Student Graduate Scholarships  
(PSU-Dent ISG Scholarships)**

Faculty of Dentistry, Prince of Songkla University (PSU) realizes that a graduate program is very important foundation for knowledge creation and high quality research publication. Graduate program is also a key for international collaboration and academic internationalization. In order to support, strengthen and internationalize the graduate programs, Faculty of Dentistry, PSU is proud to announce the 2023 PSU-Faculty of Dentistry International Student Graduate Scholarships (PSU-Dent ISG Scholarships) for excellent international students to study in the graduate programs at Faculty of Dentistry.

**1. Number of Scholarships:**

**3. Scholarship value:**

**3.1 Full Support**

- The monthly allowance of 10,000 Baht ( $\approx$  290 USD) covered housing and living expenses.
- Tuition fee waiver (Based on program of study)
- A travel expense to and from home country at the beginning and the end of the scholarship term respectively (not more than 15,000 Baht or  $\approx$  429 USD)
- Coverage of health and accident insurance during the period of scholarship in Thailand (not more than 2,900 Baht or  $\approx$  83 USD)

**3.2 Partial Support**

- Tuition fee waiver (Based on program of study)

**4. Application Requirements:**

- 4.1 International students with good academic record and research experience.
- 4.2 Eligibility is restricted to graduate students who are expecting to begin his/her study at PSU in 2023 academic year.
- 4.3 The subject in which the previous degree was obtained must match and fulfill the requirements of the program's curriculum.
- 4.4 The applicant must not be a recipient of another scholarship that covers living expenses during the same period.

4.5 The applicant must pass an officially recognized English language examination as follows:

**Doctoral degree**

- PSU-TEP score of 70
- CU-TEP score of 70
- TOEFL (Paper Based) minimum score of 500, or  
(Revised paper delivered test) minimum score of 46, or  
(Institutional testing program) minimum score of 520, or  
(Computer Based) minimum score of 173, or  
(Internet Based) minimum score of 61, or
- IELTS score of 5.5

**Master degree**

- PSU-TEP score of 65
- CU-TEP score of 65
- TOEFL (Paper Based) minimum score of 450, or  
(Revised paper delivered test) minimum score of 34, or  
(Institutional testing program) minimum score of 450, or  
(Computer Based) minimum score of 133, or  
(Internet Based) minimum score of 45, or
- IELTS score of 4.5

\*English proficiency test result need to be valid within 2 years before the commence of program.

## 5. Terms and Conditions:

5.1 The scholar must be a full-time student with a Non-immigrant “ED” visa (Study Permit). The scholar entering Thailand on a tourist visa cannot enroll and may have his/her scholarship cancelled.

5.2 The first monthly allowance shall be paid to a scholar's Thai Bank Account when the scholar presents at the Faculty of Dentistry and signs the contract within the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the month.

5.3 The scholar must study and perform the research thesis with an endeavor.

5.4 The scholar must report the progress of his/her study to the Faculty of Dentistry every 6 months.

5.5 The scholar must pass the proposal examination in a third semester.

5.6 To fulfill the scholarship requirements, the scholar must follow the graduate requirements of each graduate program and must publish his/her dissertation in reputable, peer-reviewed international journals as follows:

5.7 Once an applicant has been accepted for a particular program of study, the scholar is expected to complete the study within the given time frame and cannot change to a different program of study.

5.8 If the scholar has no progress on his/her study or thesis without proper reasons, the committee of each graduate program has to inform the Faculty of Dentistry to terminate a scholarship.

5.9 Other terms apply as established by the Faculty of Dentistry.

## 6. Required Documents:

6.1 A completed scholarship application form

6.2 A copy of English proficiency certificate (valid within 2 years)

6.3 Curriculum Vitae (CV)

6.4 A certified copy of transcript of records for bachelor’s and master’s degree study with grades and grade point average in English

6.5 Statement of purpose (about 800 words)

6.6 First page of published research articles (If any)

6.7 Research description/plan in English (2-4 pages)

6.8 A copy of the main passport page

**REMARK:** The graduate programs of the Faculty of Dentistry reserve the right to reject an application if the required documents are not completed.

## 7. How to apply:

Application form including the required documents must be submitted in PDF file to E-mail: paweenrat.n@psu.ac.th. within the due date of application period. The applicants shall get the notification email of application receipt within 3 working days, otherwise, resubmission must be made.
