AGREEMENT ON COLLABORATION PROGRAMS BETWEEN PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY FACULTY OF DENTISTRY AND

TOKYO MEDICAL AND DENTAL UNIVERSITY FACULTY OF DENTISTRY, GRADUATE SCHOOL

Prince of Songkla University, Faculty of Dentistry and Tokyo Medical and Dental University, Faculty of Dentistry, Graduate School have agreed upon promoting academic collaboration and scholarly exchange between the two institutions, including the following activities:

- a) basic and clinical research
- b) graduate studies and continuing education
- c) exchange of information and materials in fields which are of interest to both parties
- d) exchange of faculty and staff
- e) development of student exchange programs

Implementation of exchange or other kinds of operation based on this agreement shall be dealt with between the departments or faculties concerned on a case-by-case basis. A specific plan shall be worked out for each collaborative activity. The plan shall ensure that appropriate arrangements for studying, living and travel expenses are made before the arrival of a faculty member or a student to the host faculty.

This agreement becomes effective for one year from the date of the signatures. Upon expiration of each year of this agreement, unless either party has previously notified the other party in writing of its intention to terminate this agreement, this agreement will be automatically extended for an additional one-year period.

This agreement is subject to revision, renewal or cancellation by mutual consent.

Agreement on the Exchange of Students
between
Prince of Songkla University
Faculty of Dentistry
and
Tokyo Medical and Dental University
Faculty of Dentistry, Graduate School

In accordance with paragraph "e) development of student exchange programs" in the Agreement on Collaboration Programs between Prince of Songkla University, Faculty of Dentistry and Tokyo Medical and Dental University, Faculty of Dentistry, Graduate School, the two universities further agree as follows:

- 1. This agreement covers the exchange of students which will occur on a regular basis.
- 2. The sending university will decide which students should be sent to the other university with due consideration given to the receiving university.
- 3. The status of visiting students in the receiving institution is not that of regular students. It is agreed that the receiving institution will not be compelled to award any degree to the visiting students.
- 4. All costs involved under this agreement (except items covered by 5 below) will be borne by each student or by the sending university, although scholarships for such purposes may be obtained independently from other institutions.
- 5. The receiving university will waive all charges for tuition and other procedures involved in processing the student's application.
- 6. This agreement will allow an annual quota of two students to study for a maximum period of twelve months at the receiving university.
- 7. Both universities will recognize any credits awarded by the receiving university for courses taken as assessed according to the regulations and practices of the sending university.
- 8. Each university will, to the maximum possible extent, assist students sent to it under this agreement, to secure accommodation and in terms of achieving the study and research goals of each student.
- 9. This agreement will be in effect during the academic year 2003-2004 and be valid for five years, i.e. through the academic year 2008-2009. During the fourth year, a renewal for the next five-year period will be considered.

- 10. Matters not covered by this agreement shall be discussed by the two universities in consideration of the Agreement on Collaboration Programs between Prince of Songkla University, Faculty of Dentistry and Tokyo Medical and Dental University, Faculty of Dentistry, Graduate School.
- 11. The official text of this agreement is written in English.
