Academic development and research

- The development of joint research projects on topics of mutual interest and relevance to both institutions.
- The provision of opportunities for short-term visits of faculty members to the institutions for the purpose of research, lectures, discussions, and where appropriate to undertake aspects of staff training.
 - Opportunity for long-term studies (ie. split-site degrees) for a Master's degree or Ph.D
- The facilitation of exchange of information, including library materials and research publications, in areas which are relevant and of interest to the institutions.

Student Activities

• The provision of opportunities for postgraduate students from one university who, in the course of working towards their degree requirements, may need to undertake a part of their studies/research work in the other university because of specialized facilities being available in the latter institution. Such students would be subject to the admission criteria laid down by the receiving institution.

Financial Agreements

 Financial arrangements for collaborative research projects and other related activities e.g. organization of seminars etc. will have to be negotiated separately and are subject to availability of funds.
